

Standard System Setup


- Put the battery box PS4 onto the camera's cold shoe
- Slide to open battery compartment
- Insert 4 x AA batteries, alkaline preferred



- Slide the battery cover back to place.
- Plug the microphone into the input of the power box.



- Plug the output plug of the power box to the camcorder.
- Slide the switch from OFF to ON. You are ready to roll.



- In case there is wind noise in windy environment, slide the switch to low cut position
- Turn off the unit when finish recording. Take out the batteries before store the unit for a longer period.



Plug microphone output (not battery box needed) directly to the recording device with "plug-in power" microphone

Some of the recording devices incorporates power control for plug-in power. Some by software control, and some with hardware switch. Please make sure the plugin power is turn on.



The E421B is a shotgun microphone system that comprises with:

- E421, the shotgun microphone
- PS4 The battery base box with shock mount for microphone, and a cold shoe for mounting onto camcorder
- FD0.3WW 0.3M cable (Attached to E421)
- FD5WW 5M long cable
- S32 wind screen foam

Microphone Skill:

- Get the microphone as close to your subject as possible.
 A boom is specially helpful for video shooting.
- Always use a shock mount to reduce handling noise.
- Be careful of the wind: Outdoor, indoor air-con, fans...
- Always use a headphone or proper monitoring tool while recording. People don't close their eyes while shooting video, nor should they not to hear what sound is recorded. Superlux provides extensive line of high performance headphones, please check back at the web site: superlux. tw
- For lower cost boom pole, Superlux will supply an adapter bolt to convert landing net pole (from fishing hobby store) for mounting a microphone with standard 3/8" thread.
- Superlux plan to supply easy boom pole in the near future, please check back our web site.

Standard system setup:

The microphone is powered by the battery box. Which provides power as well as a low cut filter for lowering wind noise in windy condition. When there is no power from the recording device, or the device doesn't provide low cut filter to lower wind noise, you can always use the battery box of E421B system to power the microphone and cut out the low frequency noise.


Plug-in power system setup:

The microphone is powered by the recording device. There is no low cut filter at the microphone, but you may find this filter in the recording device. Refer to the manual of your recording device.


In this way, you don't have to prepare batteries for E421B, and can focus on your recording device.

However, you still need the suspension on the battery box, or you shall incorporate another shock mount such as Superlux HM40.

In the illustration over-left page, a boom pole was shown with E421 suspended with Superlux HM40 shock mount. The microphone is connected directly to the recording device which is a DV camcorder with plug-in power. A monitoring headphone was also shown.








To Change the Microphone Cable:


E421B system supplied with a 5M long cable for remote microphone stand mount or boom pole mount. To change the microphone cable, simply un-screw the red cap at the end of the microphone, and detach the cable from the mic.

Replace the cable, and screw the red cap back in place. And you're ready to go further with your microphone.
